



LOCAL RULES | SERRES DE PALS

1 - OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18)

Field boundaries are defined by paint lines or white stakes, and electric shepherd's sticks prevalent in this order.

2 - LAND UNDER REPAIR ACIÓN (RULE 16.1)

Natural materials such as pine needles, leaves, pine cones, branches or grasses that have been piled up as debris are considered as land under repair and are also loose impediments.

Fallen trees.

Open or closed ditches whether marked or unmarked.

3 - PENALTY AREAS - OPTIONAL DROP ZONES (RULE 17)

Hole 4, Hole 5, Hole 6, Hole 7 and Hole 8, the penalty areas come into play and are marked by red stakes.

Procedure as per rule 17.1.

4 - MANDATORY SPECIAL RELIEF PROCEDURES

Committee procedures. Section 8 E-3: 20 centimetres.

Penalty for infringement of this local rule

Stroke Play: 2 strokes - Match Play: Forfeit of the hole.

5 - RELIEF AREAS

If the ball rests on the bridges on the holes:

Hole 4 and hole 8, the ball is relieved as per rule 19 without penalty.

Exceptions: The fairways are an integral part of the course and are played as the ball comes to rest.

6 - CONSTITUENT OBJECTS

The electric shepherd's wires defining the out-of-bounds are integral objects.
